**ORDER: -**

The commissioner and Director of Handlooms and Textiles and Development Commissioner for Apparel Export Parks, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad, in his letter 4<sup>th</sup> read above has stated that the 2<sup>nd</sup> Expert Committee meeting was held on 26-9-2004 under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister for Finance and resolved among other issues, it was decided to release Rs. 10.00 crores to Andhra Pradesh State Handloom Weavers Co – Operative Society Ltd., (APCO) as a resolving fund and the same would be utilized for the purpose of procurement of stocks from the Primary Weavers Co – Operative Societies and only saleable varieties shall be purchased by Andhra Pradesh State Handlooms Weavers Co – Operative Society Ltd., (APCO). Resolving Fund will be kept at disposal of the Director of Handlooms and Textiles and Development Commissioner for Apparel Export Parks, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad and the Director of Handlooms and Textiles and Development Commissioner for Apparel Export Parks, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad shall monitor and utilization. On realization of sale proceeds, APCO shall remit the amounts to the Government through Director/registrar. Recovering of the amount shall be received by the Director/Registrar and give quarterly report to the Government on realization of funds and he has requested the Government to sanction Rs 10.00 crores to APCO as resolving fund for the purpose of procurement of stocks from the Primary Weavers Co – Operative Societies, as resolved in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Expert Committee meeting held on 26-9-2004 and also requested for sanction of Rs 10.00 crores over and above budget for the year 2004 – 05.

2. In the Circumstances reported by the Director of Handlooms and Textiles and

Development Commissioner for Apparel Export Parks, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad,  
Government after careful examination of the matter, hereby accord sanction for release of an amount of Rs. 10.00 crores (Rupees ten crores only) towards revolving fund for liquidation of stocks piled up with the Primary Weavers Co – Operative Societies by Andhra Pradesh State Handloom Weavers Co – Operative Society Ltd., (APCO).

3. The expenditure sanctioned above, shall be debited to the following Plead of Account.

and incur the expenditure in relaxation of Treasury Control Orders pending provision of funds by way of obtaining Supplementary Grant during the current financial year 2004-2005 subject to withholding the Budget Release Orders for the 3rd and 4th Quarters (2nd and 3rd installments) in respect of Handlooms and Textiles,

The Director of Handlooms and Textiles and Development Commissioner of Apparel Export Parks, Hyderabad is authorised to draw the amount sanctioned in para 2 above and incur the expenditure for the purpose for which it is sanctioned and the revolving fund is kept at the disposal of the Director of Handlooms and Textiles and Development Commissioner for Apparel Export Parks, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad and Director of Handlooms and Textiles and Development Commissioner for Apparel Export Parks, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad who shall monitor its utilization and realization by way of sale proceeds, from APCO.' The Vice-Chairman and Managing Director, Andhra Pradesh State Handloom Weavers Co-operative Society Ltd., (APCO) shall remit the amount to the Government after realization to the Head of Account to be communicated through Director of Handlooms and Textiles/Registrar. Recovering of the amount shall be reviewed by the Government quarterly. /
